Overview

Intrinsyc Software's i-RIL and i-MUX middleware products reduce the time required to develop a mobile embedded device utilizing Microsoft's Windows Mobile Software for Pocket PC or Smartphone and a GSM/GPRS modem. i-RIL provides developers with a common hardware abstraction layer and the i-MUX provides improved performance on single interface modems



🔅 i-RIL

i-RIL is a customized layer of software code that operates with Microsoft's Cellcore telephony stack, which is part of the Widows Mobile Software for Pocket PC and Windows Software for SmartPhone platforms, and is pre-configured to interface with a variety of wireless GSM/GPRS or CDMA2000 modems. To facilitate this process, a user customizable device driver is provided to accommodate hardware and configuration functions in your particular product.

i-MUX

i-MUX is a powerful unique software layer that creates a number virtual COM ports that enable multiple simultaneous streams of voice and data between your wireless modem and your applications. For example, this allows you to receive SMS notifications or signal strength indications while using the modem as a voice phone.

i-RIL Specifications

The i-RIL is split into two separate components, an i-RIL driver which processes AT commands, and a RIL proxy which performs arbitration between the multiple clients for access to the single RIL driver.

Listed below is a summary of the features implemented by the i-RIL API:

- Network services operator selection, signal status, available operators, etc.
- Call control dial, hang-up, hold, transfer, etc.
- Supplemental services call waiting, call forwarding, call meter, etc.
- SMS send, receive, SMSC selection, etc.
- Data connection virtual serial port, bearer service types, transparent data/online mode change

i-MUX Specifications

The multiplexer is a standard Windows CE device driver which provides two or more virtual COM port interfaces for a single modem serial port. It uses a packet switching mechanism as defined in the GSM 27.10 specification.

Listed below is a summary of the features implemented by the multiplexer device driver:

- GSM27.10 basic operating mode
- GSM27.10 advanced operating mode
- Support for all GSM27.10 packet types (except for error recovery specific packets)
- GSM27.10 convergence layer 1
- Supports modem flow control signals
- Pass through mode allowing transparent access to the underlying serial driver
- Multiplexer enable and disable API functions to allow packet switching to be turned on and off at will, without effecting the higher software layers.
