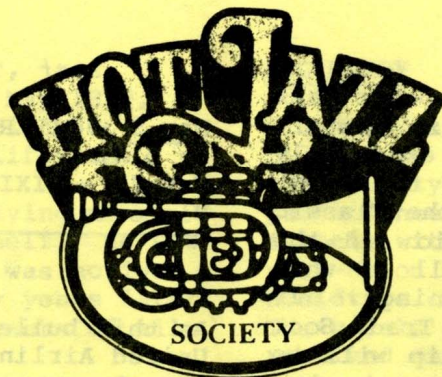

The following Special Resolution will be presented to the membership at the meeting:
Constitution -

The bylaws be ammended to read:

6(b) THE NUMBER OF DIRECTORS OF THE SOCIETY SHALL BE TEN WHO WILL SERVE TWO-YEAR TERMS. SIX NEW DIRECTORS SHALL BE ELECTED AT THE MAY 8 1979 MEETING. HOWEVER, FIVE WILL BE ELECTED FOR THE FULL TWO-YEAR TERM AND ONE FOR A ONE-YEAR TERM TO COINCIDE WITH THE EXISTING FOUR DIRECTORS.

[N.B. The elected candidate receiving the least votes will serve the one-year term.]

The Nominating Committee of the Board of Directors has selected the following members to fill the six positions that consist of the three positions which are maturing as well as the three proposed positions:

ALEX ANGELOMATIS - running for re-election, Alex is currently Vice President; is mainly responsible for bringing out-of-town bands in to the country; liason between board and bands; running the record raffles.

DICK CALDWELL is an active member of the Society whose professional talents would greatly assist the Board of Directors.

MIKE COX - former Director and active musician in the Society. He previously was responsible for advertising and care of club premises.

LEN KING - running for re-election, is responsible for the band scheduling every month and has very good knowledge of Jazz.

RUTH RISTO - running for re-election, is currently Secretary and Bulletin editor; is responsible for most of the paper work.

DAVE ROBERTS - Long-time member of the Society and a band leader who has been active in promoting jazz without and within the Society.



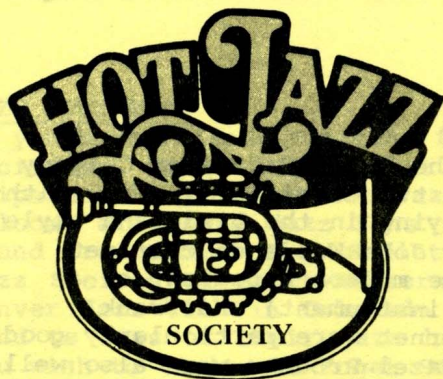
