Virtually every instrumentalist of renown has received part of his/her music training in an orchestra where he gains that awareness of true discipline of sound and structure that audiences have come to expect.

Through the Vancouver Youth Orchestra full orchestral training is provided for the student as a valuable supplement to private study on the instrument.

With two separate divisions led by a Resident Conductor, widely acclaimed Guest Conductors and Section Coaches, many of whom are from the Vancouver Symphony, the student adds an important dimension to his life and receives a high calibre of orchestral training.

The Vancouver Youth Orchestra reaches out into the community through concerts in hospitals, community centres and theatres. The Orchestra collaborates in workshops and concerts with the Music Department of the University of British Columbia and other Youth Orchestras in the Province.

**FREDERICK NELSON** was appointed Music Director / Conductor in September, 1978. He is a former member of the Vancouver Symphony, the Purcell String Quartet, the Quebec Symphony, and the Montreal Symphony Orchestra. He is presently a member of the faculty of the Courtenay Youth Music Centre. As a student Mr. Nelson attended the University of Texas and the University of Colorado where he was awarded "Outstanding Music Student" citation in 1966. Mr. Nelson studied violin with Andor Toth and chamber music extensively with the Hungarian String Quartet (Zoltan Szekea, Lilian Fuchs and Leonard Shure).



## To join . . .

The student must demonstrate sufficient competence on his instrument and will be placed in one of the orchestras, either the Senior or Intermediate Division. Weekly rehearsals are held on Saturdays at the Music Centre in Vanier Park. The yearly fee is \$95.00/student.

## Bursaries . . .

are available to students in financial need. Yearly applications are received by the Chairman of the Bursary Committee. The awards are to assist in expenses related to music study.

are available and are awarded by competition. Prizes include substantial cash awards and a solo performance with the orchestra in concert during the season.
